




A pack costs £6-00 (plus P&P).

Hillview Horse Books


These have been specifically designed for older children with a low reading age. They are aimed mainly at those in the junior and lower secondary years but could also be used by younger children who are developing into competent readers. They can be used either as general interest books about horses or as a non-fiction resource for literacy work.



Each pack consists of 7 core reading books, 1 wordbank and 1 workbook and costs £22 (plus P&P)

Gypsies and Travellers

This is intended for use in secondary schools and is great for helping students to form opinions and think about citizenship, especially Human Rights and Diversity as they apply to everyone. Further sections involve research into Gypsies and Travellers and what happens when Human Rights are denied and Diversity is not respected or valued.



The pack costs £22 (plus P&P) and contains:

- A 50 panel photographic exhibition entitled “**Gypsies and Travellers**”
- “**The Life of a Welsh Romany Gypsy**” - a short autobiographical story by Caroline Smith
- **CD-Rom** containing teaching/learning plans for KS3 Citizenship, teacher guidance and student activities for individual, group and whole class study
