

Musical Instruments Connect 4 Game - Teachers Notes

Learning Objectives

- That musical instruments produce sound in different ways –by shaking, plucking, blowing and banging.
- That musical instruments are used world wide.

Preparation

- Colour print this document, laminate each and layout the grid (over 3 pages) and cut out the cards.

Instructions

Depending on the age and ability of the children:

KS1:

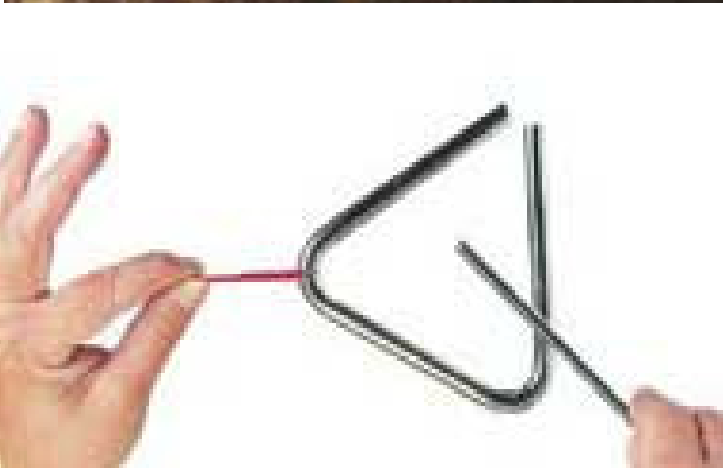
- Discussion of cards
- Children can sort and group the different photo cards of instruments.
- Children can match the photo cards to the grid.
- Children can play connect 4 game – two teams with a set of cards each, turn over one at a time and place on the grid. The first team to get a line of 4 wins the game.
- Children can describe an instrument to others who have to draw it from their description.

KS2

- Starting point for unit of work .
- Assessment activity.
- Discuss which part is vibrating.
- Suggest and discuss how you could change pitch and volume on each instrument.
