Pay As You Go Services

Education Welfare Service **NEW!**

The Education Welfare Service provides the facility for subscribing schools to purchase additional EW time on a Pay-As-You-Go basis.

Schools are encouraged to plan for, and purchase in advance, any additional sessions they may require beyond their subscription entitlement (this will increase the likelihood of the additional sessions being delivered by the school's link EWO).

We understand that a six month notice period is required in order to cancel subscription to a complete service, although the level of individual services purchased may be varied throughout the trading period through negotiation with individual traders.

The purchase of additional services can be made at any time throughout the period of the Trading agreement.
